

Enrollment

There are a number of very important points to remember regarding enrollment:

- a) If a continuing student fails to enroll for one semester (except summer), re-entry to the Graduate School will be necessary before enrollment will be possible.
- b) Late enrollment is no longer permitted by the Graduate School. Check the Timetable for current enrollment deadlines. Those deadlines vary depending on the term (i.e., fall, spring, or summer).
- c) Enrollment is required for all graduating students. The minimum credit load for students anticipating graduation is two graduate-level credits for M.S. candidates.
- d) Enrollment is required for all graduate students holding Nelson Institute graduate assistantships. See Enrollment Requirements listed here:

- e) Students who are awarded teaching assistantships in other departments should verify enrollment requirements with those departments.
- f) During summer sessions, students who use university libraries, computers, or faculty time should be enrolled.
- g) Students with fellowships, traineeships, visa eligibility requirements, campus housing, or loan obligations may have specific or unique enrollment requirements and should be aware of what those requirements are. Those requirements may be above and beyond what the student's graduate program or the Graduate School requires.
